

“Acting Up” Drama Team

What is the drama team?

The drama team is a student led team committed to developing and acting out scriptural messages through theater arts. The team will be performing skits for Wide-Open and Ignite High School Ministry services on a semi- monthly basis.

Who gets to be on the drama team?

The drama team will be made up of freshmen, sophomores, juniors, and seniors all committed to sharing their faith and the gospel message through drama. To be included on the drama team will require a commitment to attend rehearsals and performances, to be on time and ready to perform. Members of the drama team have to be able to memorize a reasonable amount of lines, use improvisation as needed, and be committed to the creative process of theater.

What does the drama team do?

The drama team will perform skits at the Ignite services as well as the Wide-Open services at an estimated two services per month. The drama team will also have once monthly meetings where members will practice using fun acting games, learn how to become better performers and grow as a team.

What commitment is required to be on the drama team?

- Be a part of the High School Ministry at Hillside Community Church through regular attendance either on Sunday nights or Tuesday nights and involved in other serving opportunities.
- Attend all rehearsals for which you are scheduled
- Attend all performances for which you are scheduled
- Attend the scheduled monthly team gatherings
- Invest whatever amount of time it takes to memorize your lines and prepare for your performance
