COST: All classes are \$10 each. If you pay for all classes at one time, the rate goes to \$8 per class. For Hip-Hop/Jazz or Tap/Ballet there are 7 weeks – a tuition total of \$56. For Artistic Gymnastics, pending on the time of registration, the tuition is \$8 x the number of classes still left in the semester.

Registration is available online for the full tuition amount. If you plan to pay per class, you must register in person at the Information Booth or Church Office and at least 24 hours in advance.

NOTE: All classes need a minimum of six registrations to make/confirm a class. IF we do not get enough, we will either combine classes or cut them until the next semester (a refund will be given if this takes place). Classes cannot exceed 20 students so space is limited. If you decide to pay per class, a registration form is still required and 24 hours notice is needed to confirm there is space.

- Cost \$60 (covers instruction, materials, some costume pieces and a t-shirt)
